



# DO YOU HAVE A RARE PLANT CONSERVATION PROJECT THAT NEEDS FUNDING?

The Pennsylvania Plant Conservation Network (PPCN) is pleased to offer mini-grants for rare plant recovery projects on private lands statewide. This includes plants **listed** as rare, threatened or endangered

These mini-grants will provide money for fencing, propagation, mowing, equipment, professional consultations, and monitoring following restoration projects and/or invasive species control.

These projects will help the PPCN extend our reach onto private lands.

## Criteria

- Project is targeted to conserve rare plants versus general ecosystem stewardship
- Demonstrated long-term commitment to the project
- Grantees will submit reports & present to the PPCN Annual Stakeholder meeting in 2021
- Project budget must not exceed \$35,000
- Project should be "shovel ready" as funding must be spent by June 30th, 2020

## To Apply

Please **submit** a word document with the following information:

- Your name, organization, and contact information
- A brief (300 words or less) description of project and how it targets rare plants
- A brief description of any organizations that you are able to partner with for this project -- Letters of support are appreciated
- Budget with narrative explaining how funds will be used
